Building heating services technicians plan and calculate heating systems. They draw the plans, monitor installation and commission the systems.

### As well as performing the following tasks:

- Clarifying system requirements with architects, engineers and building owners
- Detailed calculations for production and installation
- Drawing detailed plans for workshop and assembly personnel
- Producing operating manuals and issuing instructions for safe operation
- Commissioning systems and checking that they work properly
