Job

Plumbing assistants ensure that new or converted buildings are supplied with hot and cold water. Under the guidance of plumbers, they help install drinking water and wastewater pipes. They also install and maintain various sanitary facilities such as washbasins, bathtubs, showers and toilets.

As well as performing the following tasks:

- Preparing work
- Producing sketches on the construction site
- Making components in the workshop
- Connecting fittings, e.g. taps, to the pipes
- Helping with commissioning
